Crosspoint Christian School Statement of Faith

- 1. We believe that the scriptures, both Old and New Testaments, are the inspired Word of God, without error in the original Hebrew and Greek writings. The Bible is the complete revelation of His will for the salvation of men and is the divine and final authority for Christian faith and life.
- 2. God is the Creator of all things, infinitely perfect and eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- 3. Jesus Christ is true God and true man having been conceived of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He died on the cross as a sacrifice for our sins according to the scriptures. Further, He rose from the dead, ascended into Heaven, where he sits at the right hand of the Majesty of High. He is now our High Priest and Advocate.
- 4. The ministry of the Holy Spirit is to glorify the Lord Jesus Christ, to convict men of sin, regenerate the believing sinner, indwell, guide, instruct, and empower the believer for Godly living and service.
- 5. Man was created in the image of God to glorify Him.
- 6. Man fell into sin and is therefore lost. Only through regeneration by the Holy Spirit can salvation and spiritual life be obtained.
- 7. The shed blood of Jesus Christ and His resurrection provide the only ground for justification and salvation for those who believe, and only those who receive Jesus Christ are born of the Holy Spirit and thus become children of God.
